Objectives

The aim of the project is to support the recognition of learning outcomes of formal, non-formal, and informal learning in the field of health and social care on the basis of the ECVET instruments and principles.

In international cooperation of educational institutions from Germany, Belgium and Italy methods and instruments for the description, assessment, recognition, and transfer of learning outcomes will be developed. The project will support the mobility of skilled workers and help to close the gap between staff supply and demand in the field of health and social care.

Project Outcomes

- Units of learning outcomes including ECVET points for nine professions in the field of health and social care from Germany, Belgium and Italy (amongst others: Geriatric Nurse, Health Care Assistent, Family Helper)
- Comparison of the learning outcomes on the basis of the examined professions for national permeability
- Common assessment standards on a competenceoriented basis
- Model for personalized transcripts of record according to the EUROPASS transparency instruments
- Development, transfer and implementation of extra curricular qualifications for central professional competences on the basis of the learning outcomes of the examined professions

Methodologies for

- the description of activity-oriented and competence-based learning outcomes in units according to the recommendations for ECVET and EQF,
- the allocation of ECVET credits to units of learning outcomes and qualifications,
- the definition of common standards for the assessment of outcomes of formal, informal and non-formal learning and for
- the comparison of learning outcomes.
