



Title of Extra Qualification	First aid assignment -group A (D.Lgz.81/08 eD.M. 388/2003)
Target Group (Qualification(s)):	All employees responsible for carrying out in the workplaces first aid tasks in companies classified in Group A of the Ministerial Decree n. 388 of 18/07/2003. The course is designed to promote the establishment of an efficient organization of first aid in the workplace and to increase the knowledge about first aid in case of accidents and / or illness of employees.
Duration (lessons à 45 min):	16 hours
Necessary Qualification of Trainer	He must be a qualified expert on First Aid, or a doctor.
Necessary Equipment	The only thing needed is a dummy to show the correct procedure to face an emergency.
EQF / NQF Level	Not required.
Assessment Instruments	Written test, followed by a few questions and practical explanation on the content of the course.
